Here is what Terry had to say:



“When my parents became residents of Luther Court in July 2019, I knew very little about the facility and was simply following through on a suggestion made by Vancouver Island Health Authority / Island Health. It was important to our family to keep my parents safe and together for the remainder of their lives. They entered Luther Court as independent residences and began the waiting game and balancing act that comprises aging.

Our family took a calculated risk to hold out for long term care beds at Luther Court, first for my dad and then for my mum. The outstanding care and compassion demonstrated by ALL the staff – maintenance, kitchen, housekeeping, administration, health care workers and nurses – was quite unbelievable. Not only was their excellent care and compassion directed toward my folks but also toward me.

Desperately in need of support, I was quickly enfolded and upheld by their love and dedication to their work. The marvellous culture of genuine care-giving demonstrated and permeated the entire Luther Court work force can only develop because the board and management embraces integrity, compassion and professionalism without compromise.

Luther Court is a one-of-a-kind facility! How wonderful it would be if all families could experience such care for their aging members”.

We at Luther Court embrace our commitment to providing the kind of care that Terry speaks of. We all want that compassionate, capable care for our loved ones – a care that demonstrates daily the value we place on compassion to all who enter our doors.
